Traumatic Hock Edema

2 FES Treatments to gaskin and **2 FES** treatments to lower leg

SUMMARY: Upon examination the hock was extremely swollen, heat was present and the site was tender to the touch. This was an acute injury that had occurred within 24 hours of treatment.
